One large tree in front road area near chancery had to be taken down by Jensen Tree Service for insurance purposes. The tree was rotten on the inside and the insurance agent thought it might fall at any time. The tree service also cut some branches that were hanging near the chancery

Installed ceiling fan, that was donated, in the chancery office.

Dumpster was ordered from Vogel Disposal to remove clutter that was in one-half of the chancery garage and the separate double garage near the pavilion.
